Terms and Conditions for 100% or 50% refund

Since there are numerous different 11+ grammar tests we will use the Warwickshire 11+ test as a bench mark for all children for qualifying scores.

If your child is interested in a non-Warwickshire grammar school, the following rules apply.

If your child sits the Birmingham test, you need to share the test results with Warwickshire grammar schools (it is the same test).

If you are interested in other grammar schools, your child needs to take the Warwickshire 11+ test and use it as a FREE mock exam. The test is FREE to take. Warwickshire County Council cannot prevent your child from taking the test. All you need to register for the test, by the deadline and your child should be able to sit the test. This test could be used as a free mock exam.

Waiting lists of grammar schools are maintained until 31st December of the year of entry.

If your child had not been offered a grammar school place and did not attain the **lowest score** offered to a non-pupil premium child by a Warwickshire grammar school by this date, then you can apply for a refund. We use non-pupil premium scores to be fair to you, as pupil premium scores are lower and your child may not be eligible for a place at a lower score.

We will also consider the gender of your child, to your advantage, should the scores be different for boys and girls.

You will need to make a claim between 1st January and 1st March (a 2 month period) after the year of entry. Late claims cannot be made.

Evidence required for Claim:

- **Copy of Warwickshire 11+ score, showing the name of your child.**
- **Letter from current school, showing where your child attends and permission to check,**

Note: Your child must have undertaken work that was assigned diligently. If a test was timed for 45-minutes your child should have spend the full time on the test (e.g. as opposed to 10-minutes) if they scored less than 75%. It does not matter if their score was very low, if they spent the allocated time. We will check the online history.

If you accept you child did not undertake the assigned work, you can still make a claim for half the amount you paid with no further questions asked. We cannot be fairer than this! Our offer is genuine and our terms are not designed to make it impossible to claim,

Summary: 100% refund, if your child does the work and does not score the minimum qualifying mark or 50% refund if your child has not done the work.

Note: Your child must sit the Warwickshire 11+ test or the Birmingham 11+ test and share the results with Warwickshire to be eligible for this offer. The tests are FREE to take.
